Research and doctoral education

- About 350 doctoral students: *Aalto official student registry including attending and non-attending students 20.9.2012: 349 doctoral level students (337 dr. and 12 lic.) 19% from abroad*
- Some 60 professors
- About 100 full-time researchers working on their various research topics in a wide range of disciplines.

Five departments

- Provide five distinctive perspectives into the fields of arts, design and architecture.
- The departments work closely yet transparently with each other, as well as with other schools at the Aalto University.

- **Art**

Within those areas, research is focused around central themes selected by the departments.

A common frame of reference to the areas of research at the School of Arts, Design and Architecture is formed by **sustainable development and its financial, social, cultural and ecological dimension**.

The uniqueness of research is enhanced by the connection between **theoretical expertise and practical relevance**, on the one hand, and **artistic expression**, on the other hand.

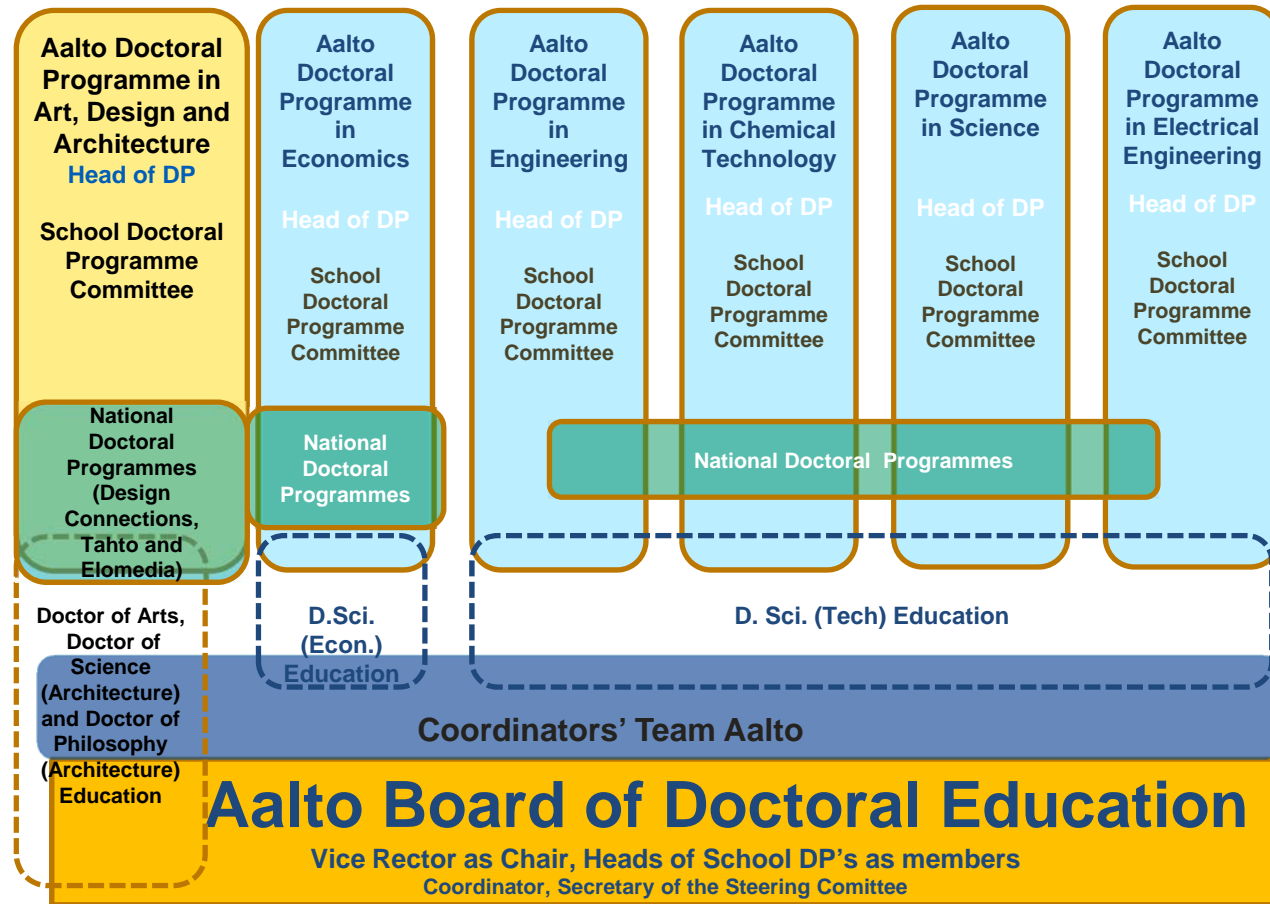

Field of Arts and Design

Doctoral studies in Art and Design have been offered from 1981, and since then a total of 109 Doctors of Arts have graduated.

Doctoral education has grown all through the period which is an outcome of extensive strategic development.

The special feature of the programme is that the dissertation can also include art or design productions.



Field of Architecture

The Department of Architecture offers postgraduate degree studies for Doctor in Science (Architecture) and Doctor of Philosophy (Architecture) degrees.

The first publication of a doctoral dissertation took place in 1921, and since then over fifty candidates have been awarded their doctoral degrees.

The Department of Architecture is the oldest and largest of the three schools/departments of architecture in Finland.

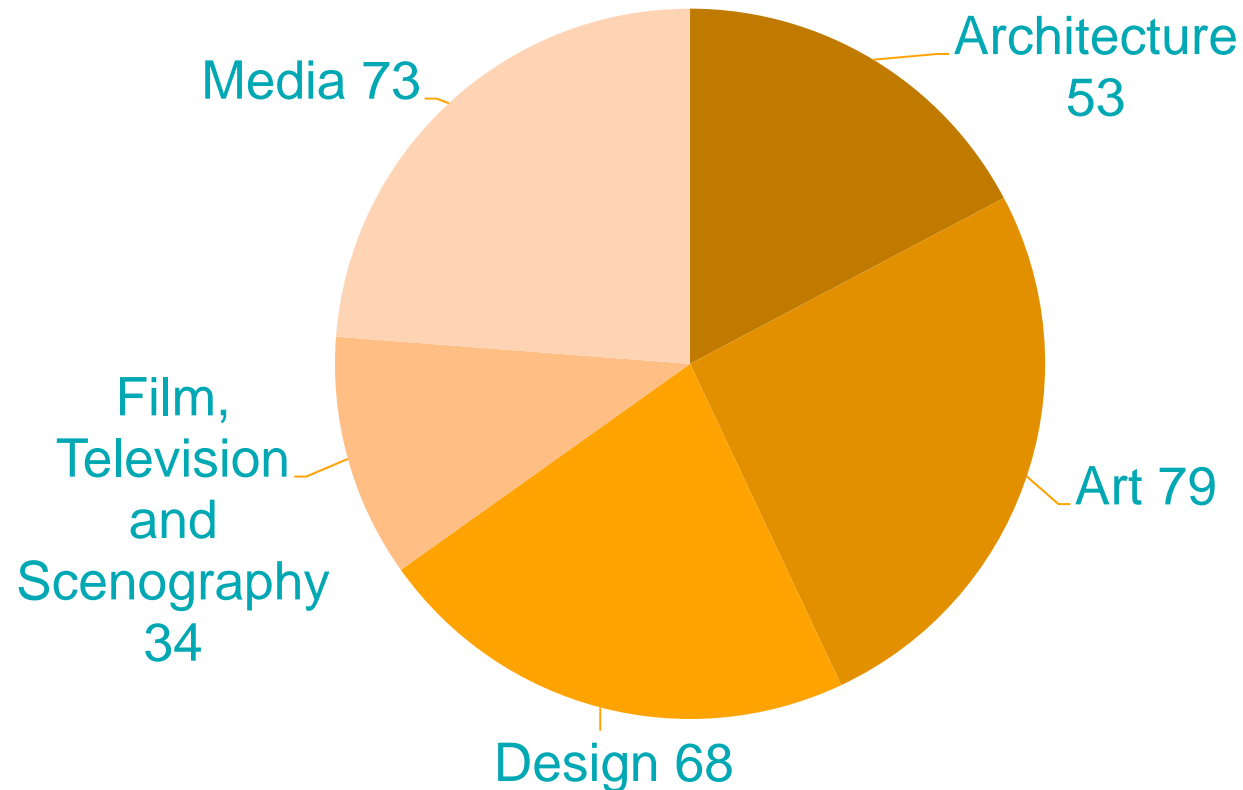

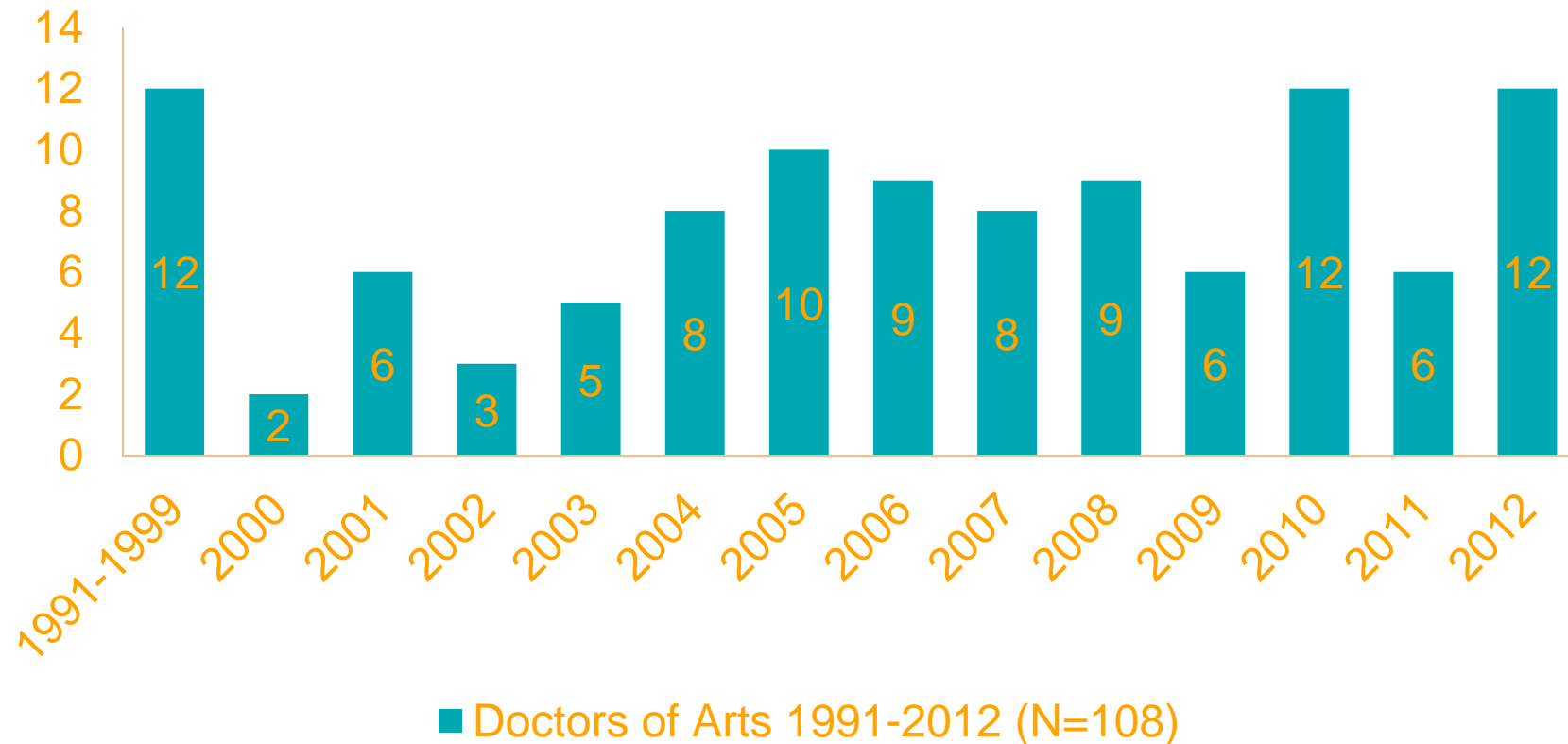

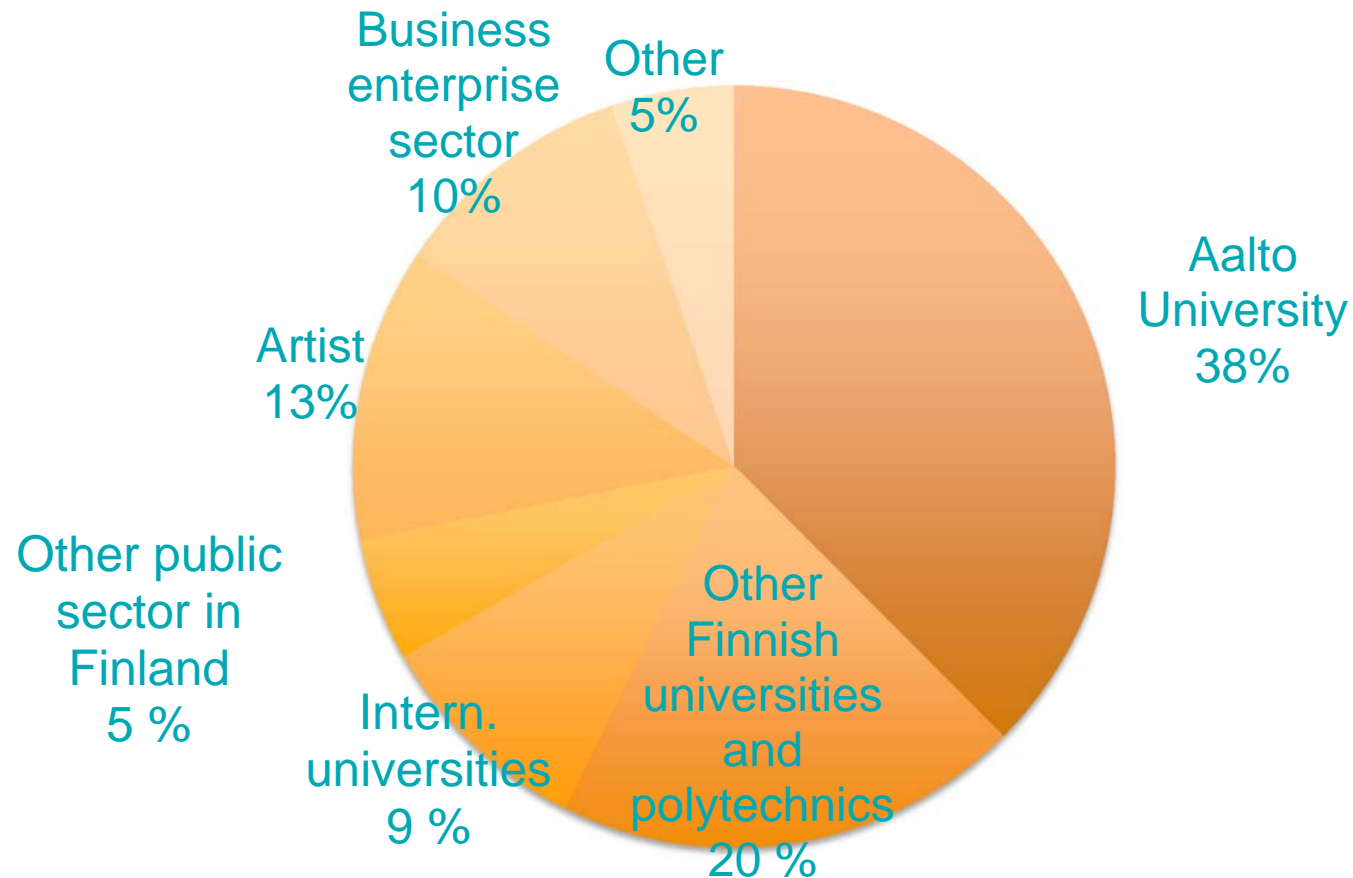

Doctors of Arts 1991-2012 (N=108)

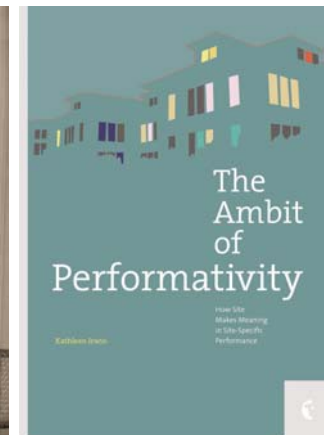
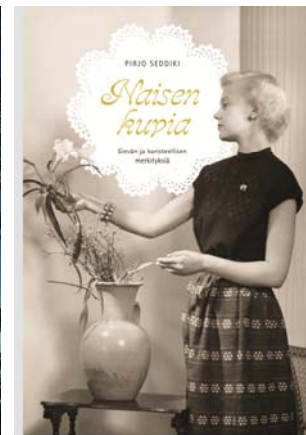
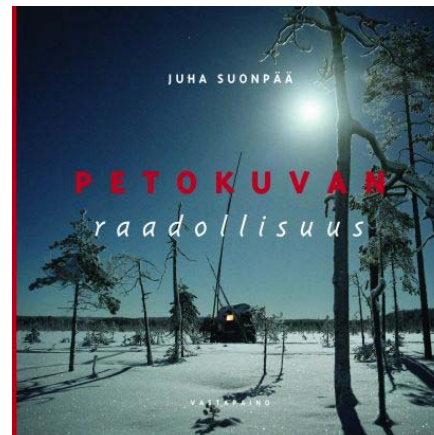
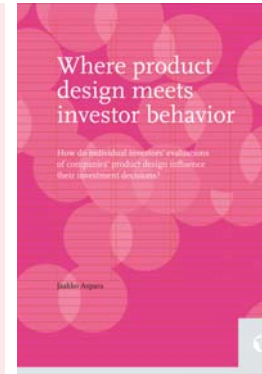
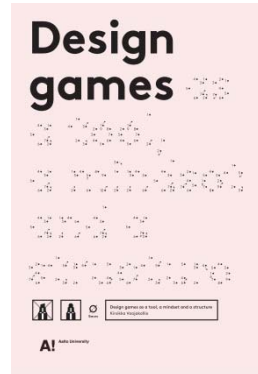
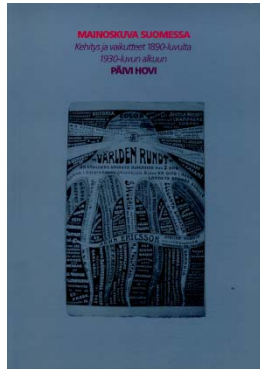


Employment of Doctors of Arts

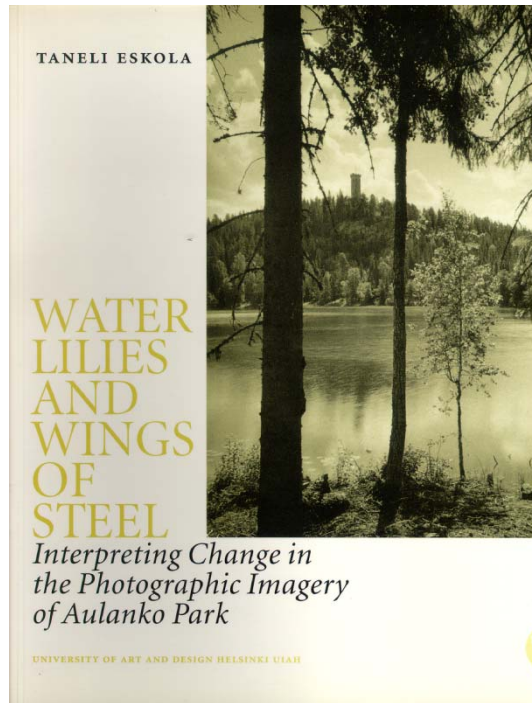
