Research and doctoral education

- About 350 doctoral students: Aalto official student registry including attending and nonattending students 20.9.2012: 349 doctoral level students (337 dr. and 12 lic.) 19% from abroad
- Some 60 professors
- About 100 full-time researchers working on their various research topics in a wide range of disciplines.

A common frame of reference to the areas of research at the School of Arts, Design and Architecture is formed by sustainable development and its financial, social, cultural and ecological dimension.


The uniqueness of research is enhanced by the connection between **theoretical expertise and practical relevance**, on the one hand, and **artistic expression**, on the other hand.

Field of Architecture

The Department of Architecture offers postgraduate degree studies for Doctor in Science (Architecture) and Doctor of Philosophy (Architecture) degrees.






Doctors of Arts 1991-2012 (N=108)
